



How I price my kittens-

Kitten prices will vary depending on the quality (and sometimes the age) of the kitten and how closely it meets the Bengal Breed Standards. Remember, you get what you pay for. Kittens are generally priced as follows:

Pet Quality:

Meaning the kitten falls short in some small way of the breed standard I am aiming for. These kittens can still have good type, contrast, rosettes, exotic patterns, etc. and still make excellent pets with great temperaments. \$500.00 to \$800.00

Show-Alter:

These kittens meet or exceed the breed standard and would reasonably be expected to achieve Champion status in the show ring. Because I have carefully selected my breeding cats from among the best cats available many of my kittens fall into this category. \$900.00 to \$1500.00

Cutting Edge:

Though every breeder would love to claim that every kitten is cutting edge, in truth, very few are and breeders are lucky to get one or two in a year's worth of breeding. These are kittens that I would keep in my breeding program and would show beyond Champion status. These are kittens that exceed the breed standard and have outstanding attributes you would want to see in the Bengal breed. Because I have a small, selective program, I can't keep them all and do sell an occasional cutting edge kitten as a pet. Remember, these kittens are

few and far between so if this is what you are looking for, let me know. \$1500 to \$2000
